GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS 2010

BACKGROUND

The Walter and Frieda Beckman Hanners Scholarships are made possible by generous gifts of Walter and Frieda Beckman Hanners. The 1923 Preservation Foundation designates the Beckman-Hanners donation in the form of academic scholarships to Fairbury High School students.

The Hanners were raised in Fairbury and graduated from Fairbury High School in 1942. He later was involved with an aeronautical engineering division working with the development of the silo missiles throughout the United States.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

- Complete the 1923 Preservation Foundation Scholarship application;
- Be a high school senior who will graduate from Fairbury High School by June 2010;
- Be able to present current GPA;
- Complete an essay one page in length on an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper using at least 12 point font and 1.5 line spacing by choosing one of the following topics:
 1. What one extracurricular activity has meant the most to you? Explain why this activity was so meaningful.
 2. Discuss an issue of personal, local or national concern and its importance to you.
- Complete the College Funding Estimator and file the return with the application. (College Funding Estimator can be found at www.educationquest.org.)

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Two or more scholarships will be awarded by the 1923 Preservation Foundation for the 2010 graduating class.
2. An alternate will be selected in the event someone doesn't accept his or her Scholarship.
3. Each award has annual value of up to \$1,000.00 and is renewable for a maximum of four consecutive years of undergraduate study providing you stay a full-time student.
4. Any student graduating at the end of their senior year can qualify for this scholarship. However if you are a recipient of a full tuition scholarship you must surrender this scholarship.
5. These scholarships may be used at any accredited public or private college.
6. Scholarships will cease if graduation occurs earlier, if a student discontinues with his or her education or fails to maintain a 2.750 GPA.
7. All applications are reviewed by a panel of five judges. One must be the high school principal of Fairbury High School and one must be the guidance counselor at Fairbury High School.
8. After selection has been made the applicants must be approved by the 1923 Preservation Foundation.
9. Scholarship recipients will receive notification of the scholarship at Honors Night in early May. In August, when paying your tuition and fees, surrender notification of this scholarship to the Financial Aid Office. Your college will forward the request forms to the 1923 Foundation and the scholarship money will be sent directly to the financial office.
10. To renew this scholarship, students attending a school using the quarter system will receive \$333.33 per quarter for six quarters, unless the graduation requirement is completed prior to the six quarters. You must send an original college transcript to the 1923 Preservation Foundation at the end of the third quarter along with proof of registration. You must maintain a 2.750 GPA. Upon the 1923 Preservation Foundation receiving this information the scholarship will be renewed for the next three quarters. The money will be sent to the financial office.
11. To renew this scholarship, students attending a school using the two semester system must send an original college transcript to the 1923 Preservation Foundation thirty days prior to the new school year. You must maintain a 2.750 GPA. Upon the 1923 Preservation Foundation receiving this information the scholarship will be renewed for the next year. The money will be sent to the financial office.
12. Return all applications to the guidance office by March 1, 2010.
