

GLENN EBBERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND

Glenn Ebbers was a lifetime resident of Jefferson County. He graduated in 1944 from Fairbury High School where he participated in basketball, track, FFA, and National Honor Society. Following high school he worked on his father's farm, eventually taking over his family farm and continuing to farm land that has been in his family for over 90 years. He took great pride in farming. In his spare time, he enjoyed attending Fairbury High School events and participating in the Senior Olympic and Cornhusker State Games.

ELIGIBILITY/GENERAL INFORMATION

Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

- Must be a graduating senior from Fairbury High School.
- Must complete this application.
- Must provide one signed letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, high school counselor, administrator, community leader, religious leader, or family friend.
- Complete an essay on one of the two topics, one page in length on a 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper using at least 12 point font and 1.5 or single spacing:
 1. Discuss the importance of agriculture and how it has influenced your life.
 2. Explain what extracurricular activities have meant to you or how an activity has impacted your life.
- This scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior not already receiving a full tuition scholarship. If you are the recipient of a full tuition scholarship you must surrender this scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified at Honors Night. Scholarship recipient must provide notification of this scholarship to the Financial Aid Office of the college they attend.
- All scholarship funds will be sent directly to the Financial Aid Office of the college. One-half of the scholarship award will be sent each semester.
- A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to one student. One alternate will also be selected in the event a student must surrender the scholarship. The alternate will receive a \$500 scholarship.
- Return completed scholarship application to Taylor Biehl, Guidance Counselor, by April 1.
